October 6, 2010 – Miami, FL – For the third consecutive year, Voices For Children Foundation, Inc., has earned the highest rating available from the nation's largest independent evaluator of charities.

Charity Navigator has awarded Voices For Children Foundation it's top honor with a four-star evaluation. This achievement is reached by only 14% of non-profits nationwide, "indicating that Voices For Children Foundation, Inc. consistently executes its mission in a fiscally responsible way, and outperforms most other charities in America," according to Ken Berger, Charity Navigator's President & CEO.

Charity Navigator works to guide intelligent charitable giving by evaluating charities' financial health and efficiency. It calculates each charity's score based upon several broad criteria, including how much is spent per dollar raised, and what percentage of funds goes to programs versus administrative and fund-raising expenses. It then assigns a rating from one to four, with four being the most excellent rating. The ratings show givers how efficiently a charity will use their support today, and how the organization is positioned to continue providing their programs and services in the future.
